- Line item 408, that was discussed and passed unanimously in August, was officially added into the PTO annual budget and labeled as 'Donations'.

## Principal's Report-Kim Castiglione

- **School Construction** No timeline updates on the secure entrance. The doors ordered were changed to be bullet proof and this has slowed the process.
- **New Entrance Landscaping-** It is in the plans to spruce up the walkway leading to the back entrance.
- STEM Robotics Team- Overwhelming response to the fourth grade STEM robotics team has HSE with more kids on the team than the contest permits. The purchase of a second robot by PTO was approved by all in attendance. HSE will now have two teams competing. Next year, Ms Sinclair would like to look into the possibility of having additional teams for grades K-3.
- **Curriculum Night** A survey went out asking what people thought about the new format of curriculum night, nine responses with varying responses were received. Babysitting and food trucks have helped with attendance however we would like to increase attendance. Ideas for how to do this are welcome.

- Meet and Greet 8/14, 3-4pm- It was well attended, spirit wear sales were great and everyone seemed to enjoy the popsicles.
- Online Spirit Wear Sale 08/17- 09/04- Items will be in by the 21<sup>st</sup>. We haven't received any fundraising sale totals yet.
